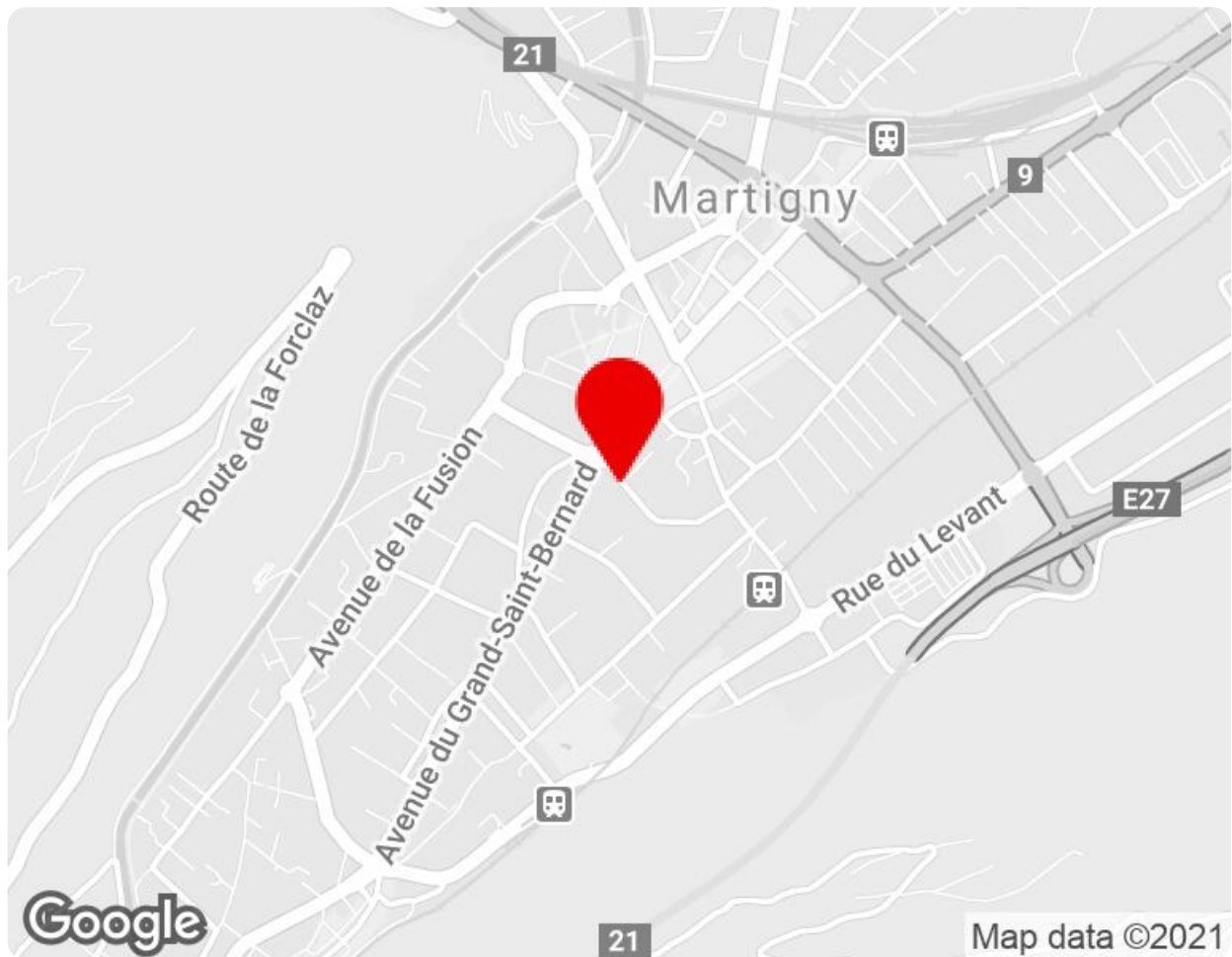




**Remains of a large family mansion, with an inner ornamental garden surrounded by a colonnade.**
