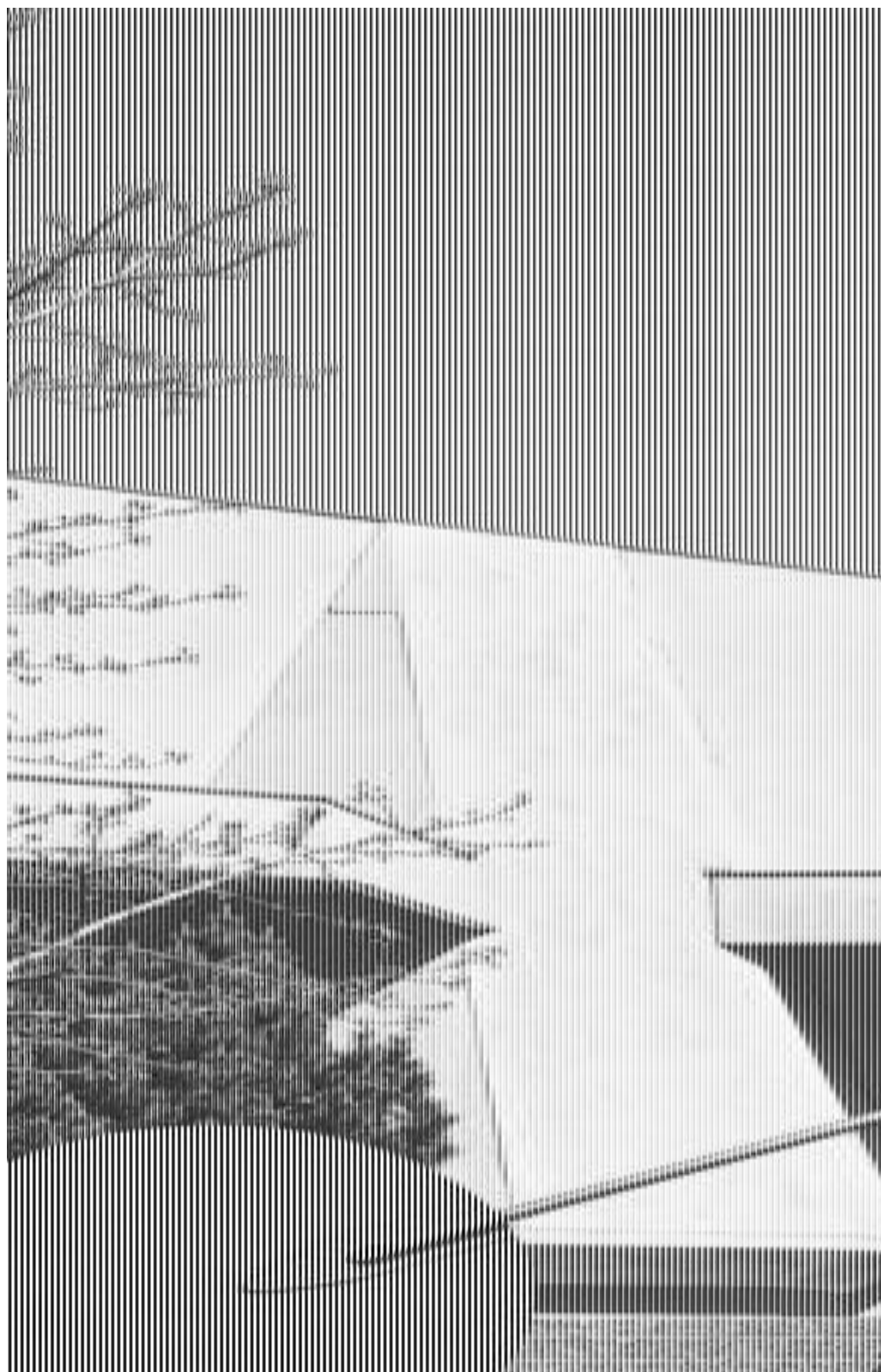
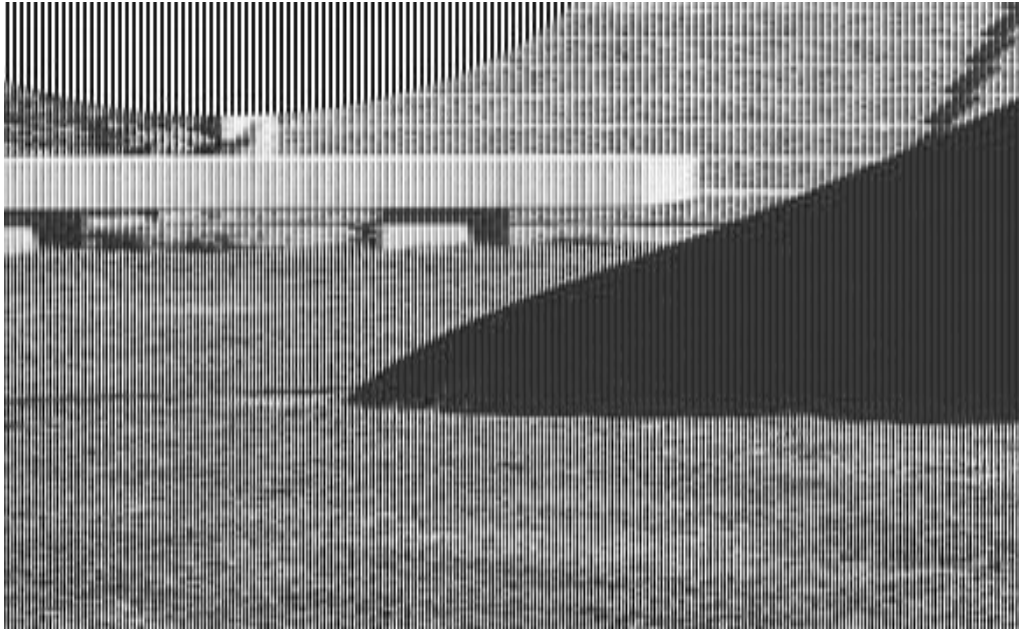
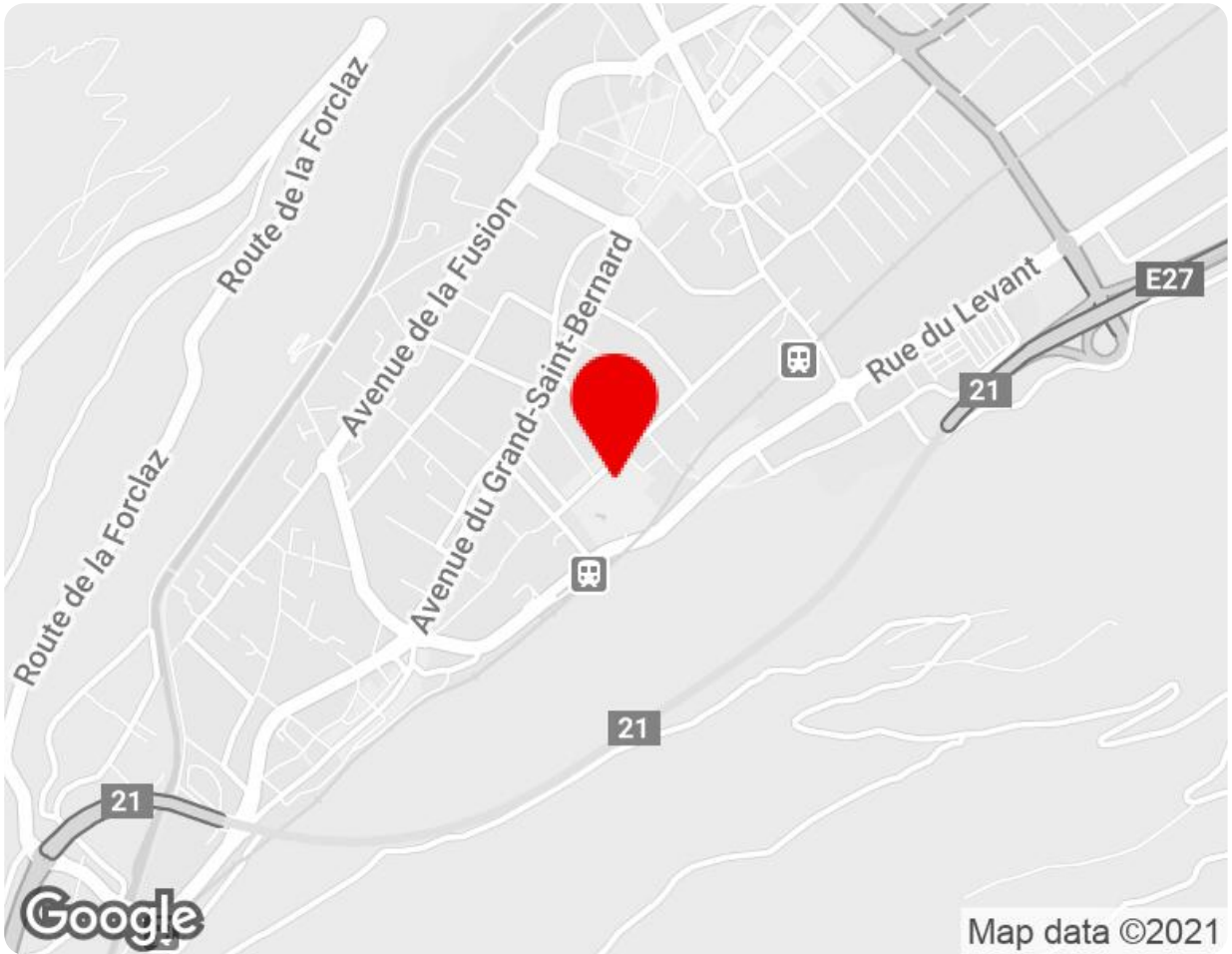

FONDATION PIERRE GIANADDA





Since 1978, the Pierre Gianadda Foundation has become an outstanding museum in Switzerland and in Europe with significant temporary exhibitions. More than 10 million visitors have already admired works from private collections and the biggest museums in the world, notably exhibitions of works by Van Gogh, Picasso, Klee, Goya, Rodin, Giacometti, Schiele, Lautrec, Chagall and Modigliani amongst others.
